

## Day 1

We board our private executive coach and depart from our designated pick up points. En route to our hotel we enjoy a guided tour (subject to availability) at The Spanish Gallery at Bishop Auckland. The gallery depicts a story of Golden Age Spanish art during the 16th and 17th centuries, exploring how its artists expressed the tension between man's yearning for eternity and the transience of life. We continue to the 3\* Best Western Plus Gibside Hotel at Whickham where we stay four nights on a half board basis.

### Day 2

Our Blue Badge guide meets us at our hotel this morning and accompanies us throughout the day. Alnwick Gardens is our destination this morning. The Duchess of Northumberland's vision was to create a beautiful public space accessible to everyone, and the garden is now halfway to completion featuring spectacular water displays, wonderful gardens and one of the largest tree houses in the world. This afternoon we visit Cragside House and Gardens, a wonderful Victorian mansion dating from the 19th century and described as 'the palace of a modern magician'. Its interior features state of the art hydraulics powering a revolutionary lift system and internal telephones which mesmerised visitors in its time.

#### Day 3

With our Blue Badge guide we travel to the Scottish Borders today. Here we visit Floors Castle, originally built for the 1st Duke of Roxburghe in 1721, and home to a fine collection of priceless European paintings, tapestries and furnishings. On arrival back in Newcastle this afternoon we visit Antony Gormley's The Angel of the North. Since spreading its wings in February 1998, The Angel of the North has become one of the most talked about and recognisable pieces of public art ever produced, winning many accolades and awards along the way.

#### Day 4

Our Blue Badge guide accompanies us on a visit to the National Trust's Lindisfarne Castle on Holy Island, a romantic 16th century castle with spectacular views that was transformed by Lutyens into an Edwardian holiday home. This afternoon you may choose to join our optional boat trip to Farne Island, one of Britain's most important bird sanctuaries. For those not choosing to join the optional boat trip, the afternoon will be at leisure in Bamburgh where you may wish to visit the Castle.

#### Day 5

Our guided walking tour of Durham with our Blue Badge guide this morning incorporates a visit to the Cathedral, once described as 'one of the great architectural experiences of Europe' and a renowned masterpiece of Norman architecture. Taking carefully selected comfort stops en route, we return back to our original pick up points.

NB:- Please note we reserve the right to alter the above itinerary if required for operational reasons. Given the historic nature of the places visited, a certain degree of walking will be involved, and this tour may not be suitable for those with mobility problems.
